#### Tell Sainsbury's not to ditch Fairtrade

Sainsbury's are removing the independent Fairtrade Mark from some of their products starting with their Red and Gold label teas and replacing it with their own label 'Fairly Traded'. Farmers in Africa are opposed to the changes as they may lose the power to decide for themselves how the Fairtrade Premium is invested in their communities.

The Fairtrade Mark is a widely recognised and trusted ethical label and provides independent assurance to consumers that meets internationally agreed Fairtrade standards. Cafod has asked us to contact Sainsbury's not to ditch Fairtrade. A joint parish letter to Sainsbury's will be available to sign at the back of both churches on the weekend of 19/20 August.
