this weekend.

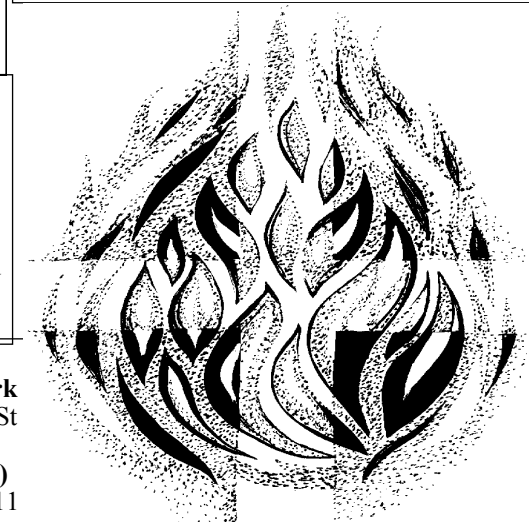
Our next Social/Fundraising event will be a
