Facts about our Diocese:



Lampedusa Cross Pilgrimage Reflection

Sicilian carpenter Francesco Tuccio made rough crosses from the wreckage of a boat carrying refugees that sank near his home on the island of Lampedusa. He offered these crosses to survivors as a symbol of their rescue and a sign of hope.
