Each parish is set a target to raise over five years. This is calculated by averaging out offertory income over the past three years, then doubling the figure. This means our target is £140,000. Of this, the parish gets 30% back to spend on a named parish project. If we exceed our target we get 70% of the surplus back, and if we double our target we get 100% of the excess back!
