There are copies of letters at the back of church, both from Bishop Mark & from the Bishops' Conference, which you are asked to read and consider before voting in the General Election on Thursday.

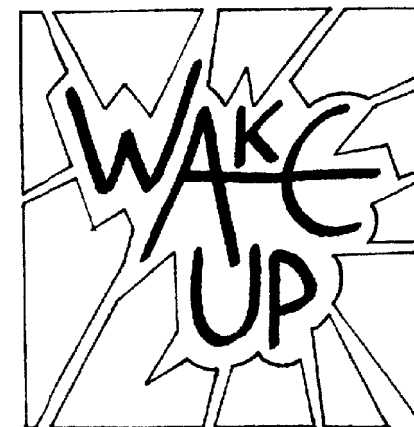
