This is open to anyone, not just parishioners. Welcome back to Mass. If you are coming PLEASE wear a mask; Social distance when queuing: sanitise your hands on entry, scan the Track & Trace app or sign in: Follow the one way system and instructions from stewards (wearing aprons to identify them). Communion in the hand only, no chalice. Instructions will be given by Fr Peter. Strict limit of 50, no exceptions. Box for offerings at back of church. Leave promptly, as instructed, at the end of Mass, not before. THERE ARE NO TOILETS AVAILABLE. WE ARE NOT ALLOWED TO USE THE PARISH CENTRE It has become obvious that we are not likely to see a relaxation in the rules governing our worship for at least six months, so we must endeavour to remain positive and find creative ways of being Church. We are hoping to have Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament each week, not only on Monday evenings, but also on Thursday mornings from the end of Mass until 12.00., and on Saturdays from 11.00 to 1.00pm. From 11.00am to 12.00 Fr Peter will normally be available to offer a socially distanced Sacrament of Reconciliation.

The government has introduced new rules which affect our celebration of some Sacraments. We can still have 30 people in church for a funeral but only 15 for a wedding, including the couple, photographer and organist, and only six for a Baptism, including the parents, baby and godparents. There are still many restrictions attached to these celebrations, and this permission could be reversed if there are more lockdown restrictions.

The number for Masses at St Mary's is still 50, but masks <u>must</u> be worn and social distancing maintained . There are still spare places at all Masses. The provision of the Masses is dependant on there being sufficient volunteers as stewards and cleaners, two for each weekend Mass and one for each weekday. We also need volunteers from time to time for weddings and funerals . Thank you those who have joined the ranks, more would be welcome! Rotas are planned separately for each week, so you do not have to make a long term commitment. Offers of help for future weekends and weekdays should be emailed to the parish office.

There is no indication of a possible end to these rules, so we need to make the most of what we CAN do, and not dwell on what we can't!
