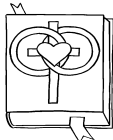

Thank you those of you who have continued to join us, in person or online. We hope that, with falling infection rates, more of you will feel confident enough to return to Mass. We are now seeing a great increase in requests for Baptism, and suggest that, if you want to arrange a baptism before the end of this year, you should contact us in the next month. Until we are able to return to a more normal pattern of worship, Fr Peter is available by appointment for any pastoral need. Weddings and baptisms are now allowed, with 30 people present. Funerals at St Mary's are now restricted to our Mass number of 50. We shall celebrate First Holy Communion with last year's and this year's groups at special Masses on Saturday mornings in late June and July, as numbers at Mass may still be restricted. Mothers' Prayers now takes place in church after Mass each Friday. Mass on Wednesday evenings & 11.00am Sunday will be streamed

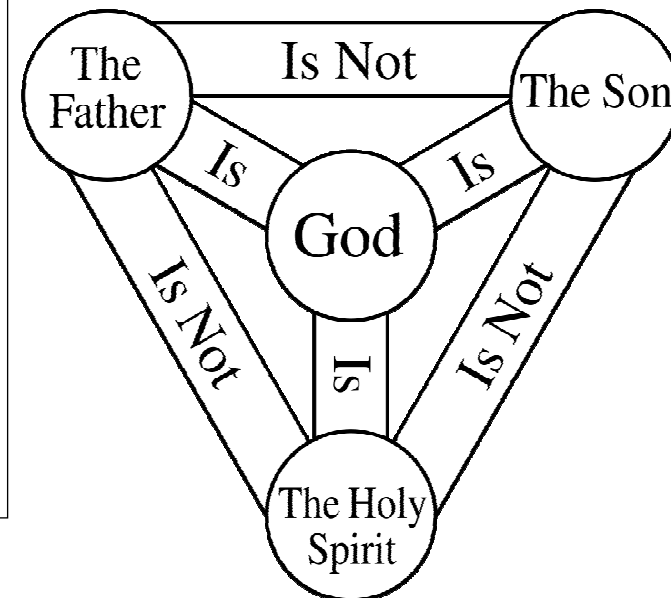
