Over these many years , Volunteers have driven and accompanied patients to thousands of Health Centre and Hospital Appointments as well as providing a Friendship Service . Sadly the decision has been made to close down the Organisation. Please pray for the generous people in the past who have given so much of their time and love to help others. Perhaps God has another plan! Thank you those of you who have continued to join us, in person or online. It is good to know that one dose of the vaccine gives 70% protection even against the latest variant and two doses 90% We are now seeing a great increase in requests for Baptism, and suggest that, if you want to arrange a baptism before the end of this year, you should contact us in the next month. We have not received any update on the numbers allowed for Baptisms and Weddings, which currently stands at 30. Funerals at St Mary's are now restricted to our Mass number of 50. As the hoped for relaxation in restrictions has been delayed for another month we will have to be patient. Until we are able to return to a more normal pattern of worship, Fr Peter is available by appointment for any pastoral need.

For Masses during the week we no longer need to have stewards before the Mass, but cleaners afterwards are still needed. At weekend Masses and Funerals, where 50 people are allowed, we still have to have two stewards and cleaners .

We shall celebrate First Holy Communion with last year's and this year's groups at special Masses on the next three Saturday mornings. These masses are for the families concerned only and have been arranged so that the families do not occupy places needed by other parishioners at our normal weekend Masses. Please pray for these children & their families.

Mothers' Prayers now takes place in church after Mass each Friday. Mass on Wednesday evenings & 11.00am Sunday will be streamed, but please come in person if you can There have been plenty of spare places at all Masses this past couple of weeks.

Please tell all your fellow parishioners how safe it feels in church and encourage everyone to be part of the real, not just virtual, community again. Fr Peter, Deacon Tony, Deacon Chris.
