With 19th July only just over a week away, it is now certain that there will be considerable relaxation of the restrictions to which we have become accustomed, but please do not think that this means no restrictions in church immediately. We will have to wait until the Bishops' Conference has decided to what extent we can change from present practice, and this will take at least a few days, perhaps more. Until we receive an update on the numbers allowed for Baptisms and Weddings, they still stand at 30. Funerals at St Mary's are now restricted to our Mass number of 50. Even though we already know that the wearing of masks is to be optional, we would encourage as many people as possible to wear them for Mass. Even if you personally feel confident, remember we wear masks primarily to protect others. Until further notice, stewards and cleaners will still be needed as at present.

We have celebrated last year's First Holy Communion and this year's at six Masses on the past three Saturdays . We have also recently welcomed 26 young people to our Preparation for Confirmation programme. They will be Confirmed in November. There is still time to join the programme.

Please pray for Deacon Stephen Roberts who will be ordained priest with two others at St Anthony's Wythenshawe on Friday. Many of you will know Stephen as he has frequently been at Mass at St Mary's. He will celebrate his first Mass here the following morning, but unfortunately, as numbers will still be restricted, the Mass is by invitation only

Mothers' Prayers now takes place in church after Mass each Friday. Mass on Wednesday evenings & 11.00am Sunday will be streamed until numbers are no longer restricted, but please come in person if you can. Numbers are increasing but by coming ten minutes early you can be sure of a place.
