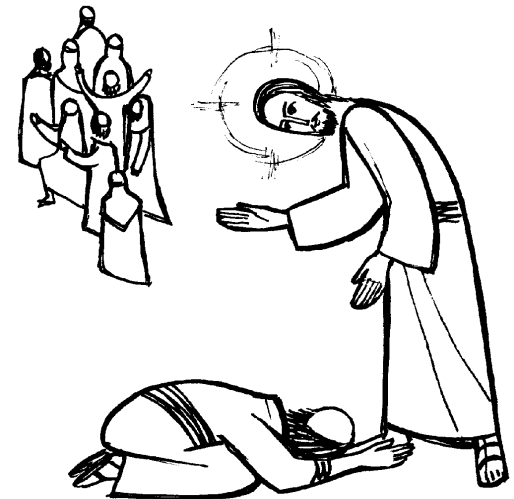
Support Mental Health & Recycle Electronic Equipment: In August we sent various equipment, including a large copy-printer, for recycling to EEE4 Disadvantaged, a registered charity who re-purpose where possible, or ethically re-cycle equipment such as phones, tablets, computers, printers, TVs etc (list of what they do & don't take on notice board) and employ people with mental & other health problems to do this. There is a small charge to cover the cost of re-cycling some of the bigger items, but some are free. For a sufficient number of items they will collect! You can find out more about them and what they take by looking at their website eee4.co.uk. If there is sufficient interest in the parish we will arrange for items to be brought to the parish centre and collected from here, but please do not bring things until we tell you when this will be as we cannot store them long term.
