We are looking for volunteers to help with the next food collection at Asda at Winsford on the 15th & 16th December with Mid Cheshire Foodbank. If anyone has a free for an hour or two, they can you go to <https://midcheshire-foodbank.appointedd.com>. Click on the book button, choose the date you want to volunteer on the calendar. In the duration drop down menu choose 1 hour, if you can do multiple hours, can you book each hour separately (so 3 hours would be 3 bookings). This makes it much easier to make any changes needed after booking and saves having to cancel and rebook bookings. In the Participants drop down menu select 1 or 2 people (if, for example you are booking for a husband and wife or with a friend. Select the time slot you want. Enter your name and contact details, check that the date and time of the "booking" is correct and the number of participants (little person icon will have a 2 beside it for 2 people) Press confirm

Parish Finances: Thank you to those who have increased their weekly giving. October Bank Statements show a further £2,000 increase, but the balance is still below last year's and we need it to be at least £2,000 above.. We have just received the first of the winter gas bills, for October, which amounts to £1027, to be paid this month and of which St Margaret's was £482. This is too high for this time of year if we are to remain solvent!
