 The day is broken into shifts from 9am to 4.30pm

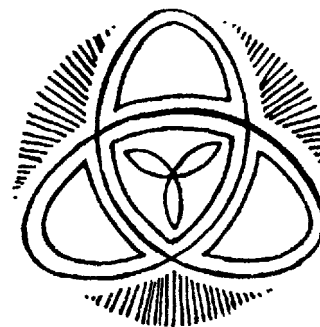
