Call for action this election

The coming general election is an opportunity for us, as Catholics, to make sure that our parliamentary candidates know that as people of faith we care for the poorest and most marginalised people both here and overseas. The SVP and CAFOD are inviting us as a parish to ask our parliamentary candidates what they will do on issues that matter to us if they win the next election. This weekend we are handing out a factsheet and a voting slip. The factsheet has information and questions which we could raise on 8 issues: the cost of living crisis; food systems; migration and asylum; climate; debt cancellation; aid and international development; business and human rights; building resilient communities and tackling regional inequalities. We would like you to choose up to 3 from the 8 issues that you would like us to raise most by ticking 3 boxes on the voting slip. We will collect the completed voting slips at church on the weekend of June 8/9. We will then email our candidates with the questions on the issues that receive the most votes. We will feedback to you any responses we receive via the newsletter. This is not about political party affiliations but about entering into dialogue.
