

# Fr. Vijay's reflection for the Second Sunday of Advent

*Prepare the way:* Advent is a time to clear away obstacles–resentment, pride, distractions–and make room for Christ.

Live in hope: Isaiah's vision reminds us that peace is possible when we allow God to transform us.

Build community: Paul calls us to unity; our parish becomes a sign of God's kingdom when we live in harmony.

As we light the second candle of the Advent wreath, let us ask: What paths in my life need straightening? Where can I bring peace and reconciliation? How can I help our parish shine as a beacon of hope? Christ is coming. Let us prepare with joy, humility, and love.

**Second Week of Advent - Peace:** (Let us pray together): Lord God, we light this second candle and remember Your call to repentance. Help us to turn away from sin and walk in Your ways. May this flame remind us of Your mercy and love. May this light help us through our journey toward Christmas to receive Peace into our lives. Amen."
