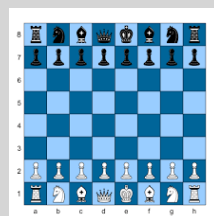

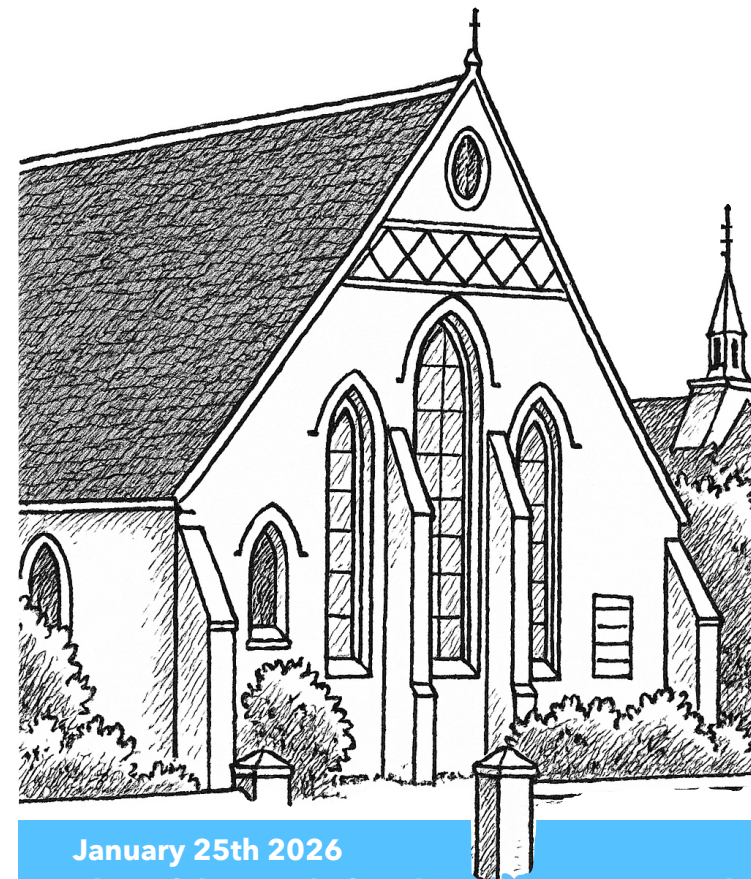

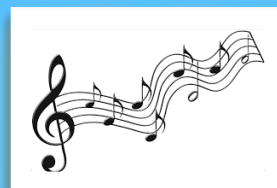
When He calls the first disciples, they respond with open hearts and willing steps. Their "yes" is simple, but it changes everything.
